November 2024— “Stop the genocide!” shout millions worldwide. “The only solution: Intifada, revolution!” It’s the only solution in Delhi, Gqeberha, San Salvador, Barcelona, and Seattle, too. Beyond “resistance” to communist revolution!

Communist revolution, everywhere. Not “national” or “democratic” or anything else. Because the genocide in Gaza is rooted in capitalism’s drive to maximize profits at whatever cost to the working class. As Marx said, “capital comes dripping from head to foot, from every pore, with blood and dirt.”

Over a century ago, that drive led unstoppably to imperialism. The most powerful national capitalists fought each other in ever-deadlier wars to exploit the global masses. World War I saw the Armenian genocide, and World War II the Nazi Holocaust. Does the Gaza genocide herald World War III?

The USA (once the world’s most powerful military) and Israel (the world’s tenth most powerful) are headed toward defeat. The US rulers, who shamelessly fund this genocide, are increasingly isolated at home and internationally. Capitalist rulers elsewhere are lining up to join the China-led BRICS alliance.

Chinese imperialism is now the global economic superpower, with 35% of the world’s industrial production. The imperialist China-Russia-Iran bloc is fighting US imperialism for world domination. It, too, is guilty of the Gaza genocide. It funds and arms Hamas and Hezbollah to tie down the US in Palestine. That, plus sharp divisions among the US rulers, diverts US imperialism from Taiwan and Ukraine. At stake, too, are the oil and gas reserves off Gaza’s coast.

But the wounded beast becomes more ferocious.

As fascism intensifies. As the global capitalist crisis deepens, we face the unimaginable destruction of world war on top of the ongoing capitalist climate crisis.

Only communism – not nationalism—can unite the international working class to build the new world we need. A world without borders or nations, money or markets, wages, or exploitation. Without racism, sexism, xenophobia, communalism, and all the other ways that capitalists turn us against our class siblings.

Only communism – not democracy – can take power into the hands of the masses so that we can collectively control our destiny. So we can contribute our labor to produce and distribute what the masses need to all who need it.

And we can get there only by mobilizing directly for communism – not for reforms, or socialism, or anything short of what we truly need.

That is what comrades of the International Communist Workers’ Party (ICWP) are doing in Gaza. “This imperialist genocide has brought out the best in the working class,” one wrote. “Money has lost its meaning. People are collec-

tively learning how to survive.... People say, ‘We did not know what communism was but what we are doing is the communist way of building our society based on necessity. We cannot go back to the old way of living.’”

These comrades are inspiring ICWP collectives worldwide. We are finding a new openness to communism. We must develop strong relationships among the masses of workers and youth who rise against the Gaza genocide. And with many more in the barracks, factories, schools, and on picket lines. We must debate disagreements frankly and respectfully.

This communist work is developing in auto factories in Chennai (India) and in maquila sweatshops of El Salvador. In working-class neighborhoods of Bengaluru (India) and Gqeberha (South Africa). In high schools in Seattle, Portland, and Los Angeles, USA.

We want to talk with you! Our party needs you among our ranks of new communist leaders. And you need our party so that a new communist world can arise on the rubble of Gaza and of the coming world war.

A “Free Palestine” for All Workers: Why It’s Necessary and Possible

“Arab and Jewish workers are brothers,” they chanted in Tel Aviv on September 24, 1945. *Thirteen hundred civilian laborers shut down British military camps in a seven-day strike. It was organized jointly by the communist-led Arab Workers Congress and the Zionist-led Histadrut (Jewish Labor Federation). “Masses crowded both sides of the streets to watch this extraordinary sight of Jewish and Arab workers marching through the heart of Tel Aviv.” (Ha’aretz)*

“One friend’s grandfather was a communist in the 1930s,” reported a comrade in Gaza. “His grandfather talked affectionately about a Jewish communist, his lifetime comrade. When I told him that ICWP is building an international working-class party for communism, he raised his fist.”

Every day the genocidal Zionist entity makes it clearer that the capitalist Israeli rulers intend to drive Palestinian people out of historic Palestine “from the river to the sea.” It can’t be re-

formed. It must be overthrown. But can enough Palestinians and non-Palestinian Jews unite to defeat the fascist Zionists? We say YES – but only by fighting to liberate Palestine from capitalism too. The masses can only be truly free in a communist liberated zone.

A Hidden History

Most Jewish migrants to Palestine before 1925 were poor and working-class folk from eastern Europe. They fled discrimination and violent pogroms. But their “labor Zionist” vision did not acknowledge that the land was already the home of Palestinians—Muslims, Christians, Jews, and others. It embraced a racist position of socialism in the service of nationalism.

The (mostly Jewish) founders of the Palestine Communist Party (PKP) rejected Zionism. They recognized it as an instrument of oppression against indigenous Arabs, wielded by the Jewish

bourgeoisie and British imperialism. These bosses exploited Jewish workers and turned them into a reserve army to dominate Arab workers.

The PKP, following the Communist International, recruited a few Palestinian Arabs. By 1934, it had decisively rejected Zionism in practice as well as in theory. Its leader was an Arab worker. But the Comintern’s “United Front Against Fascism” policy led it to uncritically support Arab nationalism, even while organizing Arab workers on the job.

Unity in Class Struggle

Palestinians, Jews, and Arabs from Syria and Egypt established the first trade union in Palestine in 1920 in the yards and workshops of the Haifa railway, telegraph, and postal services. Arab-Jewish worker solidarity flourished from

Pacifism, BDS, and National Liberation Hold Back Struggle for Communism

On March 21, 1960, the South African Police in the town of Sharpeville fired on 7,000 Black protestors against apartheid. The Sharpeville Massacre was a turning point. South African apartheid was doomed.

In 1961, the African National Congress (ANC) and the South African Communist Party (SACP) formed uMkhonto we Sizwe (Spear of the Nation). It was dedicated to resisting government terror with sabotage and guerrilla warfare. It was a national liberation movement, not a movement for communism, but it contained the seeds of armed struggle for power.

In 1962, the United Nations passed Resolution 1761. It condemned apartheid. It called for economic and other sanctions against South Africa to end legal apartheid while maintaining capitalism.

For thirty years, the anti-apartheid fight continued on both paths: armed struggle and economic sanctions.

Thousands of South African women and men joined uMkhonto we Sizwe. Tens of thousands participated in mass anti-apartheid actions. Hundreds were sentenced to house arrest and banned from public life. Many spent decades in prison. Still, the movement grew and made it harder for the South African capitalist class to govern.

Internationally, hundreds of thousands participated in “boycott, divestment, sanctions” (BDS) campaigns. They called on institutions to divest (withdraw investments) from South Africa. Activists boycotted everything from IBM to international athletics. Local and international capitalists saw their profits diminish.

It appeared that armed struggle and BDS were complementary. But appearances can be misleading.

The Cold War ended in 1991. That created an opening for the capitalists to end apartheid while maintaining racist capitalism intact.

ANC leaders, including Mandela and the SACP, dissolved uMkhonto we Sizwe in 1993 as part of the deal to end apartheid. They abandoned revolutionary struggles and accommodated to capitalist rule. This logically resulted from fighting for “national liberation.”

International sanctions were cancelled. Capitalism continued, now with Black bosses in powerful positions. South African and international capitalists still enriched themselves on the sweat of the working class.

Armed struggle and BDS were not complementary. They were contradictory. The ANC and SACP opted to reform capitalism instead of destroying it.

India: Pacifist Independence Movement Didn't Liberate the Masses

“Only communist revolution will bring Azadi (freedom) to the working class.” ICWP comrades said this to students at the Jawaharlal Nehru University (New Delhi) pro-Palestine encampment in early 2024.

Students liked this! But many believed that the BDS movement would weaken Israeli capitalists, opening the way for communist revolution.

Comrades disagreed. To win, they said, we must organize our Red Army and industrial workers to communism. The BDS movement will never get us there.

Their example was the Indian Freedom Struggle over a century ago against the viciously racist British capitalists who ruled India.

Indian middle-class anger crystallized as a nationalist freedom movement to sanction, boycott, and divest British interests in India. The Congress Party (with Gandhi and others) led it. Five of the richest rising capitalists mainly financed it. Their insistence on keeping the movement peaceful was a violent attack on Indian workers who faced the brutality of wage slavery, famine, hunger, and imperialist war.

India gained independence after the British capitalists ceased to be the top imperialists. Thus started a rapid rise of the Indian capitalist class, which kept wage slavery with ‘nationalist’ pride.

The Communist Party of India organized millions of workers, peasants, and students during this time. But it never advocated overthrowing capitalism with communism. It became a cheerleader of the Congress Party.

Today's BDS movement is similar to the Indian Independence movement. Israeli rulers are extremely weak, defended by the declining US imperialists. The horrific genocide is not a sign of strength but of their weakness.

Worldwide, the International Communist Workers' Party is organizing today to build towards a Spear of the Working Class. This international Red Army will fight until victory over capitalism and lead in building communist society worldwide.

then on. This, despite the Zionists and the Palestinian rulers, who organized Zionist para-military groups to attack Palestinians and Jews who united with them.

A united strike of Jewish and Arab truck drivers paralyzed Palestine in 1931.

The 1936-1939 Arab revolt grew out of an Arab general strike. The Palestinian elite turned it into an armed nationalist insurgency against British imperialism, Zionist institutions, and Jewish settlers. British and Zionist terrorist groups violently crushed the revolt.

Still, between 1938 and 1943 there were an average of two joint strikes a year. The 1945 Tel Aviv strike took place amidst Zionist armed attacks on Palestinians and British authorities. In 1947, on the eve of the Nakba, (1948 mass expulsion of Palestinians) a joint strike of the Jewish and Arab unions of government clerks shut down government services. Strikes of postal

workers and telegraph operators followed.

Arabs and Jews in Palestine couldn't know what was ahead. Yet they fought for unity. What they needed then, and what we need now, is to direct that unity to fight for communism.

An ICWP comrade in Gaza quoted a message from a comrade in Israel: “The Israeli government is on an insane rampage. They have alienated many. This is an opportunity to build a communist base among the masses.” The Gaza comrade commented, “This reassured us.”

In small but growing numbers, Israeli “refuseniks,” disgruntled veterans, and others are turning against their government. More are rejecting Zionism. Joint Arab/Jewish organizations are stepping up, though mostly pacifist so far.

Today we are starting to make the slogan “Workers of the World, Unite!” a re-

ality even in historical Palestine. We know now, as 20th century communists didn't, that nationalism of any kind only stands in the way.

Capitalism created nations and borders to divide the many and protect the profits of the few. Communism will sweep them away, end wage (and all other) slavery, and wipe out the material basis of fascism, genocide, and war. Communism means true liberation!

Answer Gaza Genocide and Mideast Crisis by Mobilizing for Communism Internationally

“Two million people in Gaza are learning to resist collectively,” declared a comrade there. “We must transform this opportunity into a worldwide fight for communism.”

That’s the only strategy that can end genocide, stop world war, and free the masses in Palestine and everywhere. Not reliance on the Iran-Russia-China imperialist bloc that opposes the US-NATO-Zionist imperialist bloc. Not elections, not peaceful mass protests, and not the UN. Our immediate response to the Gaza genocide and expanding Mideast war must be to mobilize masses for communist revolution.

INDIA: The ICWP garment worker collective in Bengaluru distributed *Red Flag* in their neighborhood. They asked for donations to support our work in Gaza. Many workers grabbed whatever they had and put it in our can.

A comrade organized nine regular *Red Flag* readers in her garment shop to read the Gaza letter to all 150 workers during lunch. The workers gave money and talked about communism as the only solution. Other comrades did the same.

New Delhi comrades saw parallels with Kashmir and Manipur. Capitalist governments have been ethnically cleansing the Muslim population since 1948 just as in Palestine. Comrades clandestinely distributed leaflets in South Delhi, where migrants from Kashmir and Manipur instantly identified with the Gaza genocide. “The Gaza comrade is showing us the path for the future,” the comrades concluded.

Under fascist conditions, they brought *Red Flag* to a predominantly Muslim neighborhood where masses had protested Islamophobia. “From Gaza to Shaheen Bagh, rich capitalists

have brought immense misery to people like you while amassing enormous wealth,” comrades said. “We want to end this grotesque inequality by mobilizing hundreds of millions of workers to smash capitalism. We want you to join ICWP.”

Some did right away. “We were blinded by nationalism,” a Muslim worker said. “This is the same ideology that the masses in Palestine and Israel are taught. It makes workers enemies of each other. We should be all united against the ruling class in Israel and the Palestinian nationalists like Hamas and Palestinian Authority.” He helped distribute hundreds of *Red Flag* newspapers.

In Chennai, auto worker comrades reported, “the Gaza genocide and the emergence of a new ICWP group in Israel, around the time of the Boeing strike, created many discussions that are never seen in the local media or trade unions.” They asked, “What do the expanding wars in West Asia [a.k.a. the Middle East] have to do with the Boeing workers?”

Party comrades explained the contradictions that drive the capitalist profit system. “Gaza is a perfect example of how capitalists murder the working class to eliminate ‘surplus’ workers,” they said.

“Only communism can resolve this problem, because no capitalists will exist to replace workers for profit,” a worker concluded.

SOUTH AFRICA: “Comrades here are glued to the news from Gaza. Some of us lived in the apartheid state of South Africa,” one explained. “We were very militant, brave, and fearless, but after the African National Congress (ANC) came to power, masses realized that apartheid was gone but racism was more vicious, and the oppressors were ANC.”

“We don’t fight for national liberation,” comrades declared. “We have experience here in South Africa of both apartheid and the betrayal of the so-called liberation movement, exemplified by the ANC.”

Joining masses protesting the Gaza genocide, comrades explained that “in a communist society without money, we will be able to struggle and smash all forms of racism.” They appealed especially to soldiers to be

part of the Red Army for communism.

“We participate in the solidarity strikes to show contradictions in capitalism, and to bring communism as the only solution. Fighting for national borders doesn’t solve problems that the masses face. We should mobilise our brothers and sisters for the destruction of capitalism and its profit wars with communist revolution.”

Comrades organize study of communist philosophy (dialectical materialism) among workers and unemployed youths in the townships, using the letters from Gaza. And they continue to organize toyi toyi dances at factories and in neighborhoods protesting the Gaza genocide.

ISRAEL: “We are marching for a total victory, the end of capitalism,” a comrade said as six comrades discussed how to raise communism at a huge demonstration demanding the return of the hostages. “When we the working class from Gaza to Israel unite and create a fertile ground for a communist revolution around the world.” After a sharp struggle, they mobilized a contingent of two dozen and distributed fifty *Red Flags* clandestinely amidst the ultranationalist frenzy.

EL SALVADOR: “Reading *Red Flag*, we clarify what the real motives of the war are,” commented a comrade. Factory-based ICWP collectives link the genocide in Gaza to the exploitation they face daily. They spread these discussions to co-workers and family, building for ICWP political activities. Led by comrade veterans of the guerrilla struggle, they work to get young comrades to organize in the military.

USA: Comrades have participated in marches, encampments, rallies, vigils, film screenings, and more. We have distributed thousands of copies of *Red Flag*, plus pamphlets and leaflets, at these. And more on the Boeing picket lines and among transit workers, garment workers, and high school students. We have dozens of new friends and new *Red Flag* readers. Through sharp, comradely political struggle and deepening relationships, we are working to recruit new Party members and leaders.

“Although communist revolution seems like a longer-term proposition than demanding cease-fire, it is the only realistic path,” comrades explain.

To Free the Masses in Palestine and Everywhere: Organize Soldiers and Sailors to Turn the Guns Around

“A viral video of four Israeli soldiers speaking in Arabic is circulating everywhere,” said a comrade in Tel Aviv in November 2023. “They denounce the Israeli army, saying God is with Palestine, f*** Israeli Army.”

Every time the Israeli rulers send young soldiers off to fight, many come back angry and disillusioned with Zionism.

A veteran of the elite Golani training bitterly complained that he constantly gets nightmares from his combat duty. “I killed them all. I did not spare even small children. Now I see the innocent children’s faces and I hear, ‘Why did you kill me?’ “I had the highest motivation. Only to find out they were feeding me lies.”

“I was a part of a terror organization,” said a former Israeli Air Force pilot. “This occupation is an ongoing criminal act, war crimes after war crimes. And we are not going to continue in these war crimes anymore.”

Stories like these show the explosive potential to recruit soldiers from capitalist armies to build a communist red army for revolution. Thousands of ex-soldiers are seeing that the

war only serves the ruling capitalist class.

Eighteen-year-old Tal Mitnick became the first Israeli conscientious objector imprisoned since October 7. He was active in a support network of Israelis who refuse to enlist or participate in the Israeli occupation of Palestine.

Draft resistance in Israel today recalls opposition to the US draft during its war on Vietnam. But the genocidal war on Vietnam continued until rebellion within the armed forces made it impossible for the US to field a reliable military. Soldiers refused to obey orders. Many even killed their officers to avoid combat. Meanwhile, the Vietnamese masses continued to fight fiercely.

The capitalist rulers never fight their own wars. Instead, they arm working-class youth (often the most oppressed) and send them to kill their class siblings. But soldiers don’t always comply!

In a revolutionary situation, soldiers and sailors can either support the rulers in murdering other workers or join with their class siblings to overthrow the rulers.

The collapse of the Tsarist army and navy into full-scale armed mutiny was crucial to the pro-

letarian revolution in Russia at the end of World War I. Bolsheviks (communists) mobilized soldiers and sailors to join with urban workers to topple the Tsar and seize state power.

No revolutionary movement can succeed without taking seriously the role of soldiers and sailors. That’s why organizing for communism among them, and among youth who are future soldiers, along with industrial workers, is key to the strategy of our International Communist Workers’ Party

For example, a soldier in Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth) South Africa, distributes *Red Flag* to his unit. He says that the Gaza genocide is making more soldiers see our line of recruiting communists. “The bosses are powerless if we refuse to fight for them.”

Let’s follow his lead by recruiting more soldiers, sailors, and marines from the bosses’ militaries everywhere to turn the guns on the fascist rulers and fight for communism. Let’s build one united and mighty Red Army to free the working class from wage slavery and genocide in Palestine and around the world.

Excerpts of Letters from an ICWP Comrade in Gaza**“Communism is the Future, Comrades!”**

GAZA, November 2023— The Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) has bombed all the rooftop water tanks, solar panels, bakeries, and flour mills here. Thousands of dead bodies are under the rubble. The stench spreads everywhere.

Masses are herded into hospitals that are constantly bombarded. The screaming of the injured is unbearable, and the wailing of those who find their loved ones are dead, children in shock, separated from their parents.

I have shared the *Red Flag* with friends in Gaza, Egypt, and Jordan.

Hamas is no friend of the working class. In the north of Gaza, they built ultra-luxury oceanside homes for their functionaries and other rich people. It was financed by capitalists in Egypt and United Arab Emirates. Hamas and the Palestinian Authority fought to control the prime real estate.

Not a single ultra-billionaire who controls the oil wealth in the Muslim countries has done anything to stop this genocide.

Jewish common people have helped us in Gaza over the years. They told us about Zionists who joined the Israeli Defense Forces but started rebelling when they saw that they were just occupying people in the West Bank, brutalizing them.

How I can ask people to fight for communism when they are injured, bombed, houses destroyed, no food, no water, and they have no hope? Communism is hope, based on reality. Out of 2.5 million people in Gaza, some will survive. So, I am telling all my friends here about how I am becoming a communist.

Communism in the Rubble of a Refugee Camp

December 3—We are all homeless and overcrowded. Hepatitis and viral flu are spreading like wildfire.

Red Flag has been my source of joy, excitement, and hope. I share my Arabic translation of *Red Flag* with many friends. People read very carefully about the few Israeli ex-soldiers who have denounced the war.

Top Hamas leaders grew up in refugee camps. I don't want our children's future to get wasted by Hamas or other nationalist groups. I want a red flag, not the green flag of treacherous and opportunistic Hamas. Hamas and Israeli rulers have sold out the working class.

I see hope in these children who have seen every horror of capitalism. Amid starvation, they

feed younger children. There is no rioting or looting. The adult workers have pledged to feed children first.

Some children converted a badly damaged bike into a charging station. They took turns peddling it to charge anybody's cellphones. No money was exchanged.

Such children can hold the guns to destroy our class enemy. I talk to them about war, revolution, and communism. Remarkably, war has taught them that change is possible. These children of Gaza are ready to fight for us and improve our line if we learn from them.

“Two Million People Are Learning to Live Collectively”

February 2024 — I can tell you of the inconceivable grief when the IDF targets densely populated refugee areas. There are frantic scenes of injured people, their agony of amputation without anesthesia, doctors and hospital staff desperately trying to save lives.

This imperialist genocide has brought out the best in the working class. Money has lost its meaning. People are collectively learning how to survive. Schools teach children how to harvest rainwater, how to install solar panels from the ruins, and how to sterilize injured people. Young people learn how to break into the IDF tank operators' conversations.

I have shared *Red Flag*. People say, “We did not know what communism was but what we are doing is the communist way of building our society based on need. We cannot go back to the old way. That way of living was based on the profit of rich people. Now we fear nothing. We want to rebuild everything but not the old way.”

April 2024— It gives me and my comrades the utmost joy to read *Red Flag*. I help them translate.

The comrade in Israel wrote: “The atrocities of the Israeli Zionist ruling class are making us all powerful to destroy them. Your pain is our pain. Be strong, as you are. We will be united as communists.”

Leila, age 5, was buried under rubble after her apartment building collapsed. After two nights, she was extricated. She was dizzy, disoriented, and dehydrated. There was a deep shrapnel wound on her leg.

Kids and adults lined up to donate water to wash Leila. People skipped meals so she would not go hungry. Somebody treated her leg. Leila

was smiling with the nurturing love of humanity.

Leila lost 26 family members in the airstrike. Many children like her have survived by the collective strength of the masses. Nobody made a profit by giving them food or water or healing their injuries. Society organized to eliminate profit and capitalism is the only system that can survive.

October 2024 — Amid mass genocide and mayhem, I am actively organizing for communism and our party, ICWP.

I have been displaced more than 20 times. But I am still trying to be with many friends. I Google translate *Red Flag* into Arabic and then distribute it to people around me. Most of the time we are trying to find food and water, sometimes for more than twelve hours. In the long lines, waiting for food, we talk about what communism would look like.

To imagine ICWP in Israel is amazing. We also read accounts of some holocaust survivors who have denounced Israel's genocide. We talk about the history of the Palestinian movement and how it was shaped by nationalism. The early history of the communist party encouraged nationalism.

Our party has rejected this nationalism. When we talk about this, people want to know more. They know Hamas became corrupt even though it started as a relief agency to help poor people. Nationalism made Hamas into a small group of capitalists trying to exploit the masses.

I don't want to see the future generations of survivors of the Gaza genocide be the reincarnation of Hamas. I want them to be communists and change the world. They are so resilient.

I have talked to hundreds of young people about the history of communism. I play soccer with them. I take care of their needs. They find cell towers and charge stations for me.
